

U.I.L. Eligibility Calendar 2017-18

DATE OF GRADE CHECK	DATE ELIGIBILITY IS LOST / GAINED	STUDENT ELIGIBILITY STATUS
September 29, 2017	October 6, 2017	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
October 20, 2017	October 27, 2017	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
November 3, 2017	November 10, 2017	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
December 1, 2017	December 8, 2017	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
December 19, 2017	January 10, 2018	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period become ineligible. (See Holiday Rule)
January 22, 2018	January 29, 2018	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
February 9, 2018	February 16, 2018	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
March 2, 2018	March 9, 2018	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period remain eligible. (See Holiday Rule)
March 29, 2018	April 5, 2018	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
April 20, 2018	April 27, 2018	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
	1st 6-wks ELIGIBILITY	Eligibility for students during the 1st 6-weeks - see page 3 of the TEA/UIL Side By Side
	GRACE PERIOD	All Grading and Evaluation periods are followed by a 7 day grace period which ends at the end of the school day.
	HOLIDAY RULE	All Students are academic eligible during a school holiday of a full calendar week or more.
